

# ARENA FACILITY RULES AND POLICIES

Skaters and spectators assume all risks and danger of personal injury arising from or related to admission to the Worthington Arena; including -but not limited to- being injured by ice skates, ice skaters, spectators or objects in and around the rink and in the building.

- No one under the age of 8 is allowed in the facility alone. Individuals 7 years old and under must be directly supervised by a caretaker aged 16+.
- No food OR drinks allowed on the Ice. *Water being the only exception.*
- Injuries, accidents, or equipment failures must be reported immediately to facility staff.
- The Worthington Arena is not responsible for lost or stolen items, but any lost and found items must be turned in to the office.
- No bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, etc., are permitted inside the facility.
- Shirts and pants or shorts are required in all areas of the facility. Change clothing in the restroom facilities.
- No animals, with the exception to service animals; will be allowed in the facility. *See Minnesota Statute(s) 256C.02, 609.833, 609.226, 343.21.*
- Glass containers of any type are not allowed in the facility.
- Use the equipment as it is intended to be used. Ask for help if you're unsure how to use a piece of equipment.
- No solicitation.
- Organization, Group or Team practices and programs must complete a reservation or rental of the space. The use of Open Skate or Family Skate time to conduct a practice, training or is not permitted.
- Inappropriate behavior or language is prohibited.
- Any actions, statements or behavior by players, coaches, officials, and spectators that are disrespectful to anyone will not be tolerated.

## OPEN SKATE & FAMILY SKATE

- Skaters must obey all rules and directions from Arena Staff.
- While on the ice, skaters are not allowed to carry children.
- No one is permitted on ice without skates.
- No stick or puck usage.
- No horseplay or unruly behavior.
- No jumps above axel, no double jumps, no camel spins; basic spins only done within the inner circle.
- No more than two people may skate together holding hands.
- Skating that endangers or interferes with other skaters' safety or pleasure is prohibited.
- Pass or overtake skaters carefully. Roughness, excessive speeding or weaving through skaters is prohibited.
- No tag or games of any kind are permitted on or off the ice.
- Skate in the direction indicated by Arena Staff and Rink Guards.
- No one is allowed on the ice during resurfacing.
- Do not sit on the boards or rest in the bench areas. If you need to re-tie skates, please exit the rink.
- Please use caution when entering and exiting the rinks.



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
